
DR. McNEILL BURIAL TO BE HERE SOON

Remains Will Arrive For Interment With- out Rites

The remains of Dr. Jerome Fee McNeill, a former instructor of Florida State College for Women who died Thursday morning at Thonotossa, are expected by members of the family to reach Tallahassee Monday.

Funeral services for Dr. McNeill were conducted yesterday in Orlando at the Careyhand funeral chapel, after which the body was cremated. The Rev. Mr. Fuller, a Methodist minister, officiated.

The remains of the educator, who was professor of chemistry and biology at the local woman's college for eleven years, will be interred here in the Oakland cemetery, without additional services.

Of Dr. McNeill's survivors, three live in Tallahassee. They are Miss Jessie McNeill, registrar and secretary to Dr. Edward Conradi, president of Florida State College for Women, Miss Marjorie McNeill and Malcolm C. McNeill.
